# ADMISSION PROCEDURE CRITERIA FOR SESSION 2026-27

## 1. Regulatory Framework

This Admission Policy has been formulated in accordance with the provisions of Section 17(3) of the Pakistan Medical & Dental Council Act, 2022, notified on 16 January 2023, and the PM&DC Medical Undergraduate Education (Admission, Curriculum and Conduct) Regulations, 2023, notified on 13 July 2023.

The policy governs admissions to the MBBS Program at the College of Medicine & Dentistry at the Hills, Abbottabad, for the Academic Session 2026–2027.

## 2. Eligibility Criteria

### A. Pakistani Nationals

A candidate shall be eligible for admission to the MBBS program provided that he/she:

1. Has obtained **Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSSC)** or an equivalent **12th Grade qualification** recognized in Pakistan, with a minimum of **60% aggregate marks**.
2. Has passed **Biology, Chemistry, and Physics or Mathematics** at HSSC level or an equivalent examination recognized in Pakistan.
3. Has passed the MDCAT conducted in accordance with **PM&DC Regulations (2026–2027)**.

### MDCAT Passing Marks (Session 2026–2027)

• **MBBS:** Minimum 55%

MDCAT results of previous sessions shall not be valid for admission in the Session 2026–2027.

## **B. Foreign / Overseas Pakistani Quota**

1. Private medical institutions may admit students under the **Foreign / Overseas Pakistani quota up to fifteen percent (15%)** of the total approved annual intake.

2. Eligibility under this quota shall be restricted to:

Candidates holding **foreign nationality**, or Overseas Pakistanis / dual nationality holders who have completed HSSC (12th grade) or equivalent from outside Pakistan and are residing abroad at the time of application.

3. The requirement of **MDCAT shall not apply** to candidates applying under the Foreign / Overseas quota. Such candidates must qualify:

- **SAT-II** with a minimum score of **550 in each relevant subject, OR**
- A recognized foreign **MCAT / UCAT**, with at least **50% marks** in the prescribed science subjects.

4. Any Foreign / Overseas quota seat remaining vacant due to non-availability of eligible candidates shall be **converted to open merit**.

### 3. Merit Determination (Weightage)

Merit shall be calculated as per PM&DC regulations using the following weightage:

Component	Weightage
MDCAT	50%
HSSC (Pre-Medical or Equivalent)	40%
SSC (or Equivalent)	10%

### 4. Merit List Criteria

1. In case two or more candidates obtain an equal aggregate merit up to **four decimal places**, the candidate **older in age** shall be placed higher on the merit list.
2. Merit lists shall be **published after the closure of the application process**.
3. In case of any vacancy after the display of the final merit list, admission shall be offered to the **next eligible candidate on the waiting list**, strictly on merit.
4. Candidates may submit a **written representation** regarding errors or omissions in the merit list through the **online admission portal** available on the College **website ([www.hills.com.pk](http://www.hills.com.pk))** within the stipulated time.

### 5. Admission Process

1. Applicants shall apply through the online admission portal of the College within the announced schedule.
2. **Provisional / interim merit lists** may be displayed during the admission process, as and when required.
3. All official correspondence with applicants shall be conducted exclusively through the **email address provided by the applicant** at the time of application.
4. All selected candidates shall be required to **produce original academic and personal documents** at the time of admission. Submission of original documents is **mandatory**.
5. Selected candidates and their parents/guardians shall submit a **duly attested affidavit** on **Rs. 100 stamp paper**, verified by a **Notary Public**, in the prescribed format issued by the College.
6. The offer of admission shall remain **provisional**, subject to:
  - Verification of academic and personal documents,
  - Medical fitness clearance, and
  - Payment of prescribed college dues within the stipulated timeframe.

## DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION

Applicants must upload the following documents through the online admission portal at the time of applying:

- a. Secondary School Certificate (SSC) or IBCC equivalence certificate
- b. Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSSC) or IBCC equivalence certificate
- c. Domicile certificate
- d. CNIC or Form-B of the applicant and father/guardian
- e. Passport copy (for Foreign / Overseas applicants only)
- f. Permanent Residence Permit (for Foreign / Overseas applicants only)
- g. Recent passport-size photograph
- h. MDCAT / SAT-II / MCAT / UCAT result card, as applicable
- i. IBCC Equivalence Certificate (in case of foreign qualifications)

## DEPOSIT OF COLLEGE FEE

1. Selected candidates shall deposit the prescribed **college dues within three (03) working days** of the issuance of the admission offer.
2. Failure to deposit fees within the stipulated period shall result in **automatic cancellation of the admission offer**, and the vacant seat shall be offered to the **next eligible candidate on merit**.
3. Fees shall be deposited in the **Bank of Khyber Account No (IBAN PK95KHYB5043003007993087)**

## GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. All admissions shall be governed strictly by the **Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PM&DC) Undergraduate Admission Regulations**, as amended from time to time.
2. Only the **fee for the current academic session** shall be charged.
3. All fees shall be deposited **only through the designated bank account as mentioned above**.
4. The College maintains a strict **"No Donation Policy"**. Admissions are granted solely on merit.
5. Scholarships, where applicable, shall be awarded **in accordance with PM&DC guidelines and institutional policy**.

## DOCUMENTS SUBMISSION AFTER FINAL SELECTION

At the time of admission, selected candidates shall submit the following documents **in original:**

- a. Secondary School Certificate or IBCC Equivalence Certificate
- b. F.Sc. (Pre-Medical) Detailed Marks Certificate (DMC) or Equivalence Certificate
- c. Original Migration Certificate from the respective Board / University
- d. Copy of National Identity Card or Form-B
- e. Signed Undertaking in the prescribed format provided by the College

All selected candidates **must submit their original HSSC certificate and CNIC** after admission, as required for **registration with PM&DC.**

These original documents shall be **retained by the College** and returned to the student upon **completion of the degree program and clearance at the time of graduation.**

## GAP AFTER DISCONTINUATION OF STUDIES

Any gap after discontinuation of studies shall be governed by the **rules and regulations of Khyber Medical University (KMU), Peshawar.**

## MIGRATION

Migration cases shall be processed strictly in accordance with the rules and regulations of Khyber Medical University (KMU), Peshawar.

## HOUSE JOB

House Job training shall be conducted as per the **rules and regulations of the Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PM&DC), Islamabad.**

## EXAMINATION RULES

Evaluation is an essential components of education process. In order to achieve this there are regular internal evaluations. The students are evaluated in knowledge (cognitive domain), skills (psychomotor domain) and beliefs and attitudes (affective domain). The principles of internal evaluation are uniformly applied in a transparent manner. The purpose of evaluation is :-

1. To get feedback of the students about their understanding of subject material. This purpose is achieved by periodic internal evaluation of each chapter/topic of the course.
2. To certify that the students have successfully completed the training and have achieved objectives of educational programme.
3. To motivate and encourage the students to direct their own learning.
4. To achieve these objective we adopt the following processes:
  - The students are continuously assessed at the end of a module, term, stage, chapter in the form of class tests, stage and term examination (Mid Term and Sent up Exams). Proper record of marks obtained in internal assessments, in theory & practicals are maintained and the scores obtained in these tests, stages etc contribute 10% of the final score of student in the annual / supplementary University Examination of each subject.
  - Whatever may be the system of marking for all examinations throughout medical & dental course, the passing percentage of marks in each subject is not less than 50% i.e. 50% in theory and 50% in practical.
  - If a student fails in theory/ practical in any of the examining subject, he/she will be considered failed in that subject(s). He/she will re appear in both theory as well as practical in the said subject(s) in his/her next examination.
  - To appear in any professional examination the student must complete 75% of his/her attendance in each subject as per rules of Pakistan Medical & Dental Council and Khyber Medical University, Peshawar. No student is eligible for a university examination without having attended 75% of lectures, demonstrations, tutorials, practical and clinical work in lab., inpatient and outpatient. Only those medical leave certificate would be accepted that to be issued by the consultant of attached teaching hospitals of the college, except in extreme emergency. A fine of Rs.200/-per day will be imposed on account of absence from class.
  - Only two examinations are conducted in an academic session for a professional exam i.e. Annual & Supplementary Examinations as prescribed by PM&DC and Khyber Medical University, Peshawar. No extra examination is allowed in the form of special supplementary examination etc.

- The student, who appears in Annual/ Supply examination are provisionally allowed to attend their next higher class till the declaration of results of Annual/ Supply examination of previous class. This is being done to help and provide maximum support and benefit to the students because:
- The university results of different professional examinations are usually delayed and their precious time is saved.
- After passing the supplementary examination of previous class the student will not face any deficiency in the courses of their next class.
- And they will not face short age of attendance, which make them ineligible to appear in the next professional examination according to University rules.
- No student can be promoted to next higher class unless she passes all the subjects of previous class.
- The Provisional admission does not make her eligible to appear in two different examinations in one academic session.
- A student, who reappears in her previous class professional examination in annual / supply, is not eligible to appear in new class professional examination in the same academic year.

## COLLEGE FEE

Candidates seeking admission to the **College of Medicine & Dentistry at the Hills (CMDH), Abbottabad** must ensure, prior to the commencement of the academic session, that their parents or guardians possess sufficient financial capacity to meet all college and hostel dues for the **entire five-year duration** of the program. Under no circumstances should a student default on financial obligations at any stage due to financial constraints.

Medical education is a highly demanding and costly professional undertaking, requiring sustained academic rigor, dedication, and an unwavering commitment to learning. Any interruption during the period of education or clinical training is unacceptable, as it compromises both professional development and institutional standards. In addition to the expenses associated with academic instruction, clinical and hospital-based training entails substantially higher costs.

As the College operates on a **self-financing basis**, it is mandatory for all enrolled students to pay their dues **in full and within the prescribed timelines**. Payment of fees in installments is **not permitted**. However, students who demonstrate exceptional academic performance—such as securing top positions in university professional examinations—may be considered for **financial assistance or monetary awards**, subject to the recommendations of the relevant committee and prevailing institutional policies.

### RULES REGARDING PAYMENT OF COLLEGE DUES

#### 1. Timely Payment of Dues

All students are required to deposit their college dues immediately after the annual examination and before the commencement of the next academic session. Failure to deposit dues within the stipulated timeframe shall attract a late payment fine of Rs. 500 per day, in addition to the prescribed college fees and other subscriptions. Students who fail to comply with this regulation shall not be permitted to attend classes, laboratories, OPDs, wards, or **appear in examinations**, and may also be **liable to expulsion from the hostel**.

#### 2. Payment by New Entrants and Migrated Students

All newly admitted students, including migrated students, must pay the full college dues, fees, and applicable subscriptions for the class in which admission is sought at the time of enrollment.

#### 3. Refund of Security Deposit

The security deposit shall be refundable upon leaving the College, provided it is claimed within six (06) months of the date of departure. Failure to claim the security deposit within the specified period shall render it non-refundable, and the amount shall be transferred to the College Benevolent Fund for deserving students.

#### 4. Fee Liability in Case of Supplementary Examination or Detention

Students who qualify in the supplementary examination shall have their admission to the higher class regularized. However, students who fail to qualify in both the annual and supplementary examinations shall be required to **repeat the relevant course(s)** and deposit the prescribed **readmission fee along with all applicable college dues** for the class in which they are detained.

All financial transactions shall be conducted exclusively through the above mentioned designated account. The College shall not be responsible for any transaction made into any other account whatsoever. Cash dealings of any kind are strictly prohibited and shall not be recognized or accepted by the College.

Any student who secures **First Position at the University level** in a professional examination shall be awarded a **50% reduction in tuition fee for the subsequent academic year**, in accordance with institutional policy.
